Sarojini Naidu – Gottfried Wilhelm Leibniz Leadership Award 2017

Call for Nominations

The award is meant to honor the Indian students association that has contributed most towards facilitating the needs of Indian students in Germany including, but not restricted to:

- Supporting Indian students community in the region
- Helped integration of Indian students in Germany
- Contributed to cultural diffusion between Indian and German cultures
- Supported and contributed to development of the ISG Platform

The award (two awards) shall be awarded during the **Mahatma Gandhi Birthday Celebrations** in Hannover (Germany) and will include a citation accompanied by a cash award of **€1000 each**. All events conducted by the association during the period of **01-Nov-2016 to 01-Sep-2017** shall be considered during the decision process.

Interested Indian associations will need to submit a formal application, highlighting their contributions, **no later than 20-Sep-2017**. The application should include:

- Cover letter
- Contact details (mailing address, phone numbers & email) of the office-bearer submitting the application
- Information about the association with links to websites & social media sites
- Information on all events conducted by the association in two separate categories: cultural and educative/discussion
- Links to website or social media sites or screenshots (preferred) for corroboration of the above information
- Information on contribution towards development of the ISG platform
- Efforts made by the association to increase student registration in the Database
- Financial budget of the association (any funds received from sponsors, donors etc.)
