THE STORY OF INDIAN COFFEE

Indian coffee's journey began over 400 years ago when the saint Baba Budan brought seven coffee seeds from Yemen to the Chandragiri hills of Karnataka in the 17th century. This humble beginning grew into a rich coffee culture, and by the 19th century India emerged as a commercial producer, exporting coffee continuously for over 150 years. Grown under shade in biodiverse forests and nurtured by generations of farmers, Indian coffee today represents a unique blend of heritage, sustainability, and world-class quality.
