India has emerged as the fastest growing major economy in the world and is expected to be one of the top three economic powers of the world over the next 10-15 years, backed by its strong democracy and partnerships. India's GDP is estimated to have increased 6.6 % in 2017-18 and is expected to grow 7.3 % in 2018-19. In April-July quarter of 2018-19, the GDP grew by 8.2 %. India has retained its position as the third largest startup base in the world with over 4,750 technology startups, with about 1,400 new start-ups being founded in 2016, according to a report by NASSCOM. India's labour force is expected to touch 160-170 million by 2020, based on rate of population growth, increased labour force participation, and higher education enrolment, among other factors, according to a study by ASSOCHAM and Thought Arbitrage Research Institute. India has jumped 23 places to 77th rank (out of 190 countries) in the World Bank's Ease of Doing Business rankings. Last year India had improved its position by 30 spots to be counted among the top 100 countries.

The focus of the “**India Business Day in Schleswig Holstein**” will be on ongoing developments in India and initiatives taken under the GOI' different initiatives. The experts will inform participants about the “Current Economic Scenario in India”, the developments in different sectors (such as life science, renewable energy and manufacturing) and legal/tax systems and benefits of doing business in India.
